

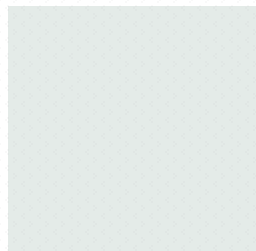

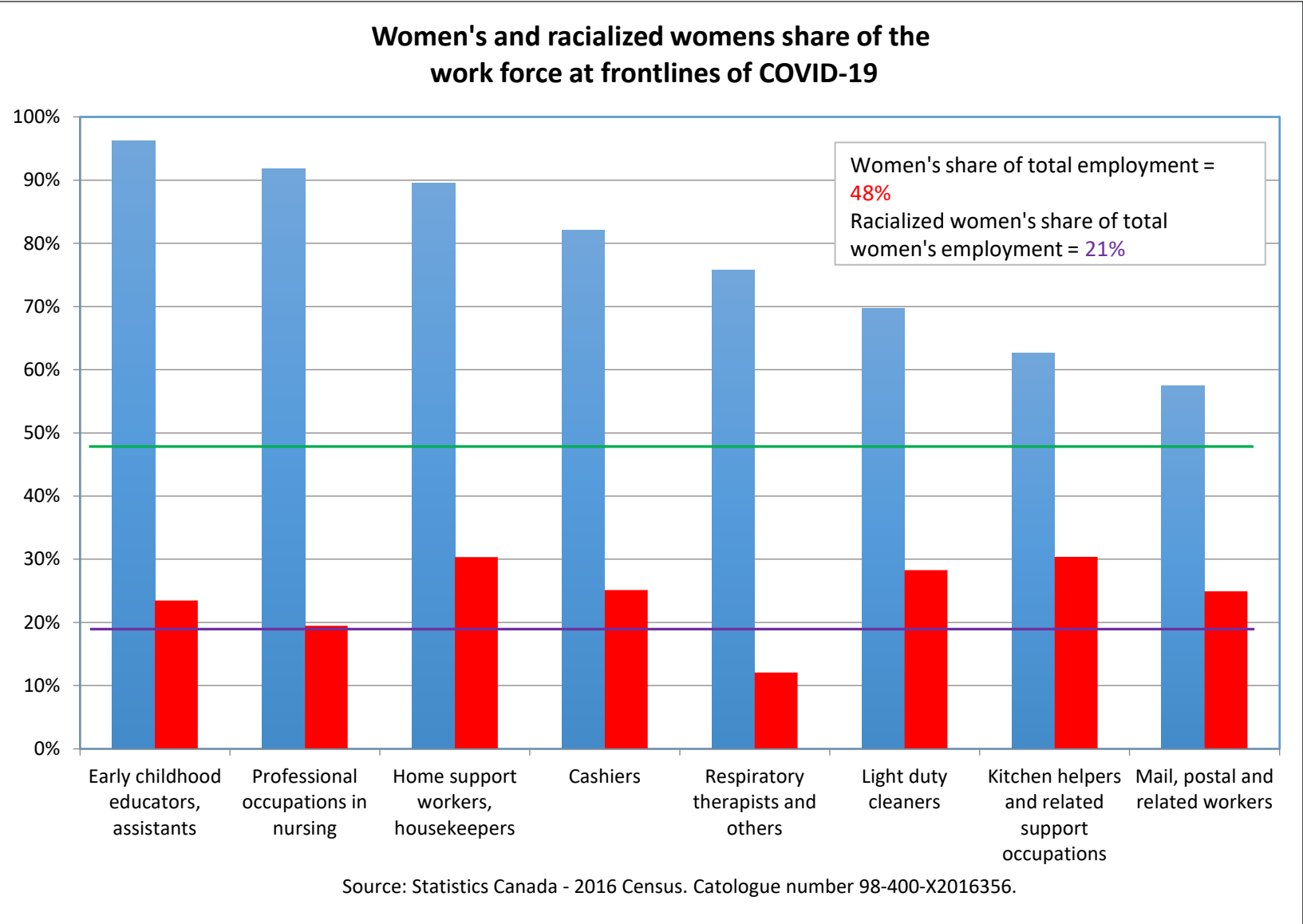

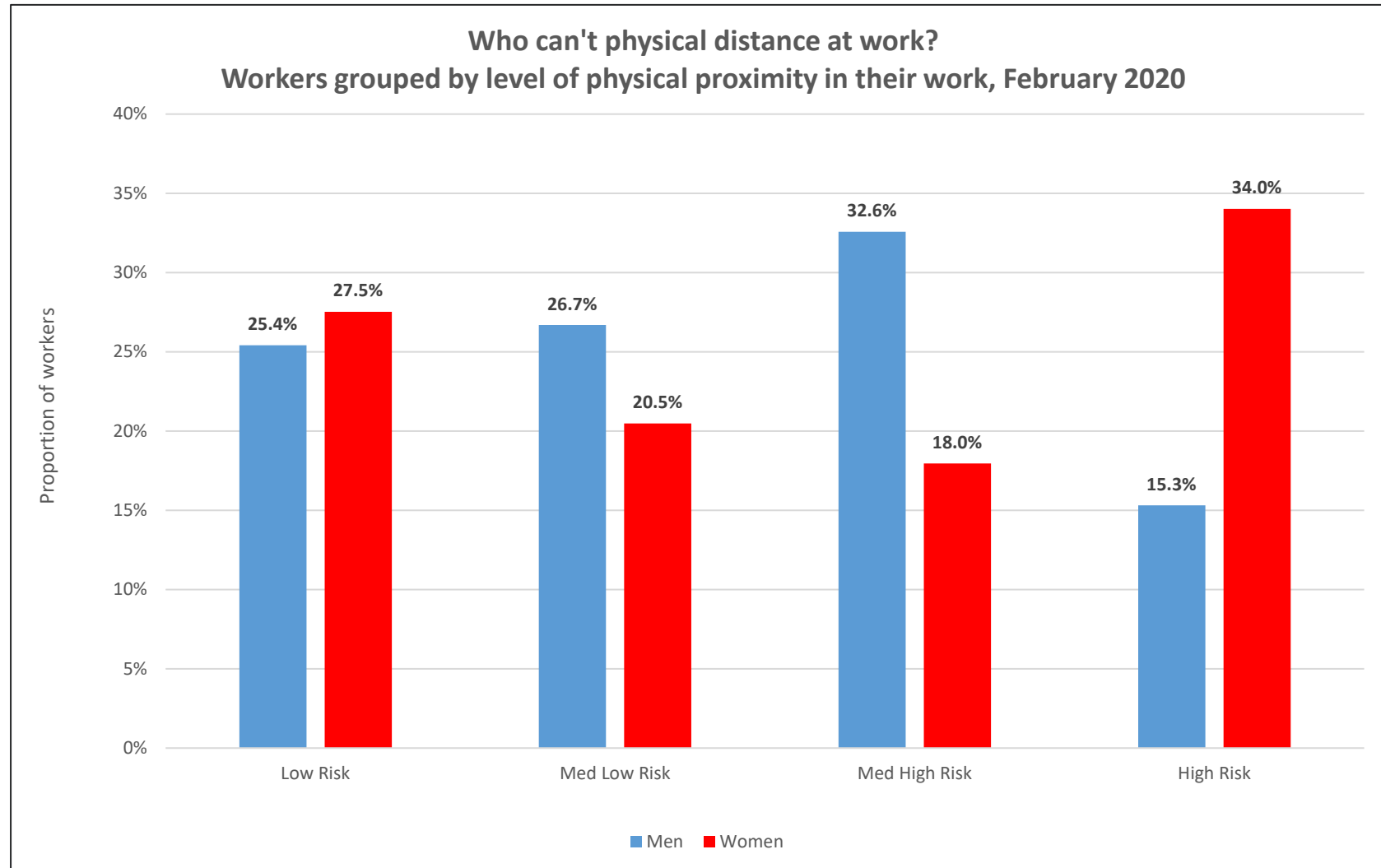

# 1. Women are on the frontlines

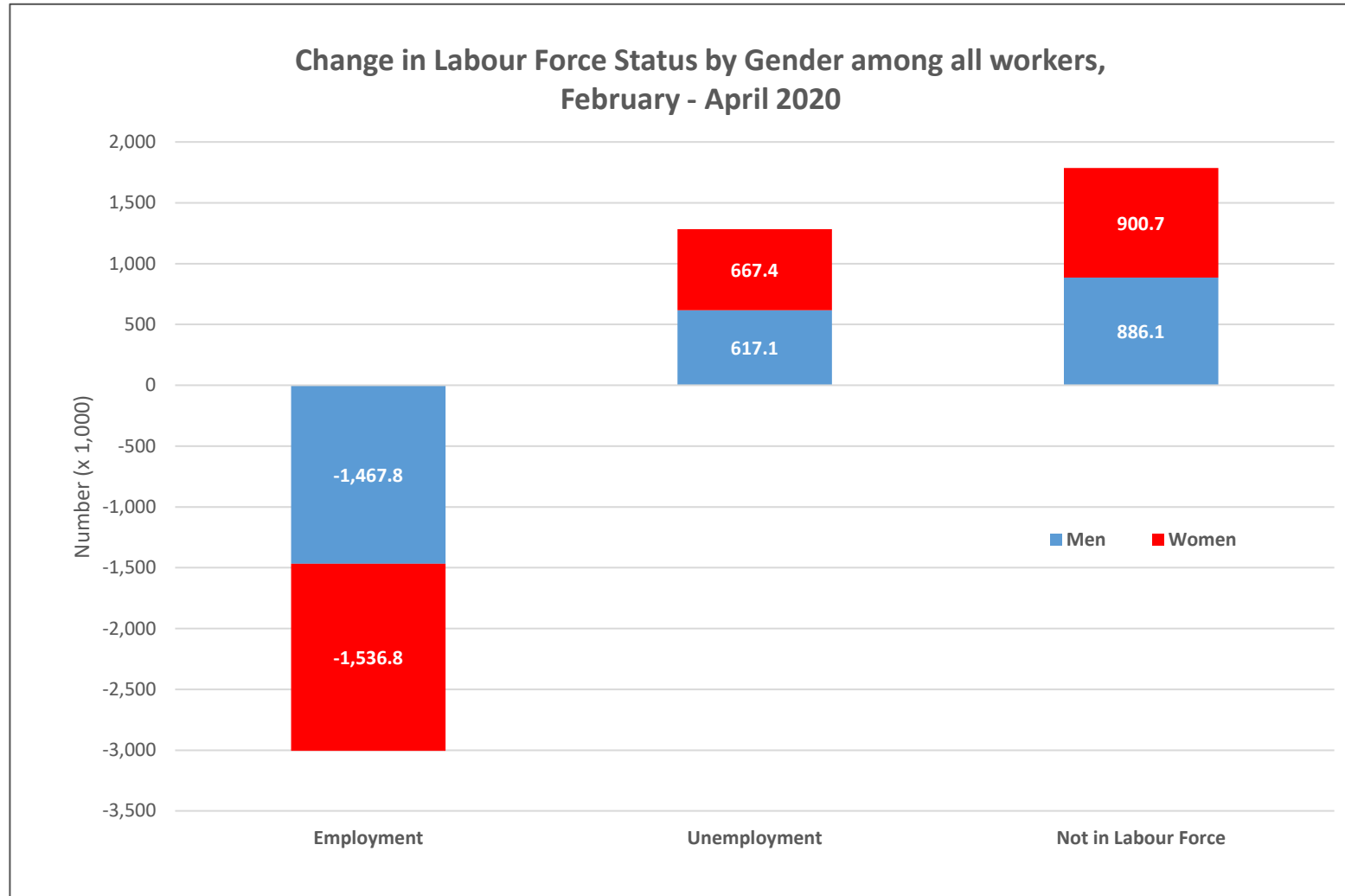


## 2. One-third of female workers are at risk



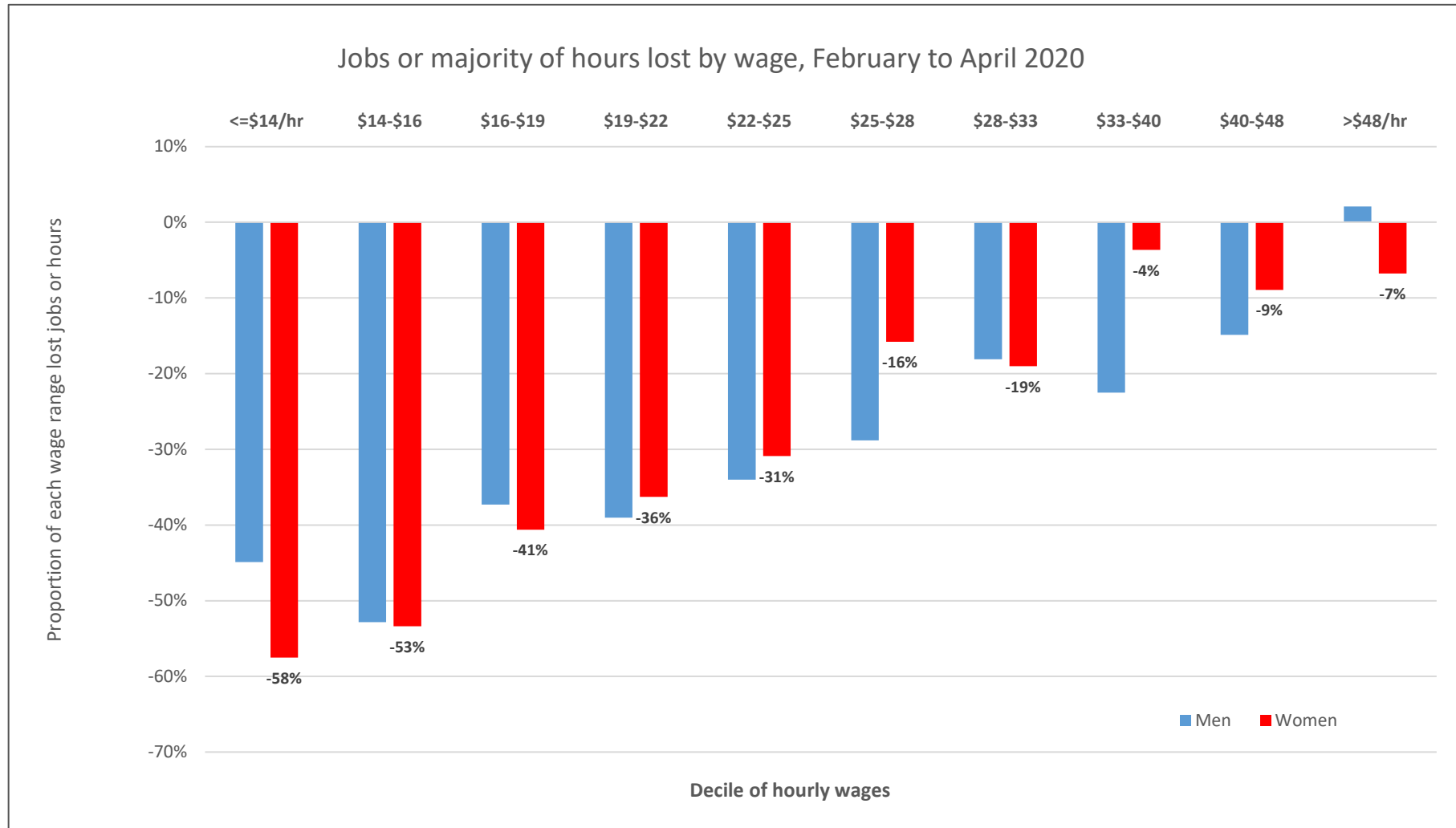

# 4. Low wage workers are being hit hardest

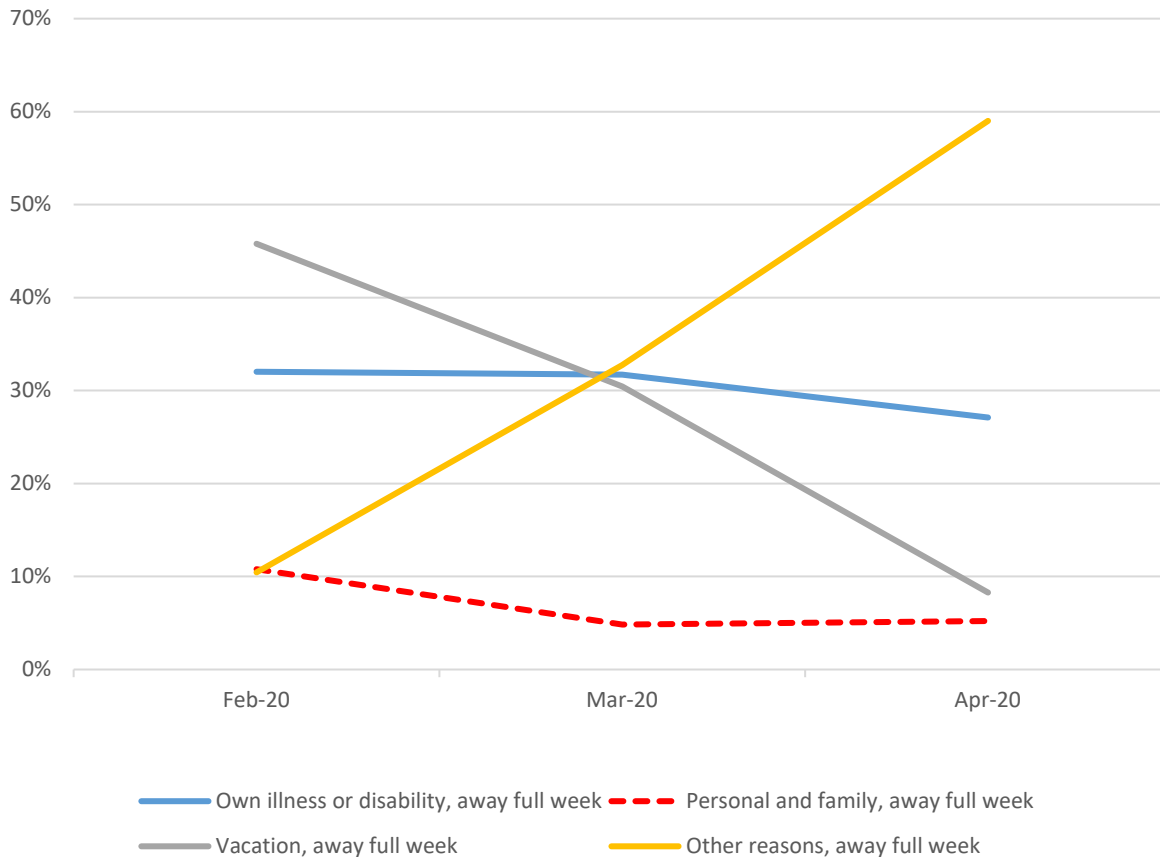

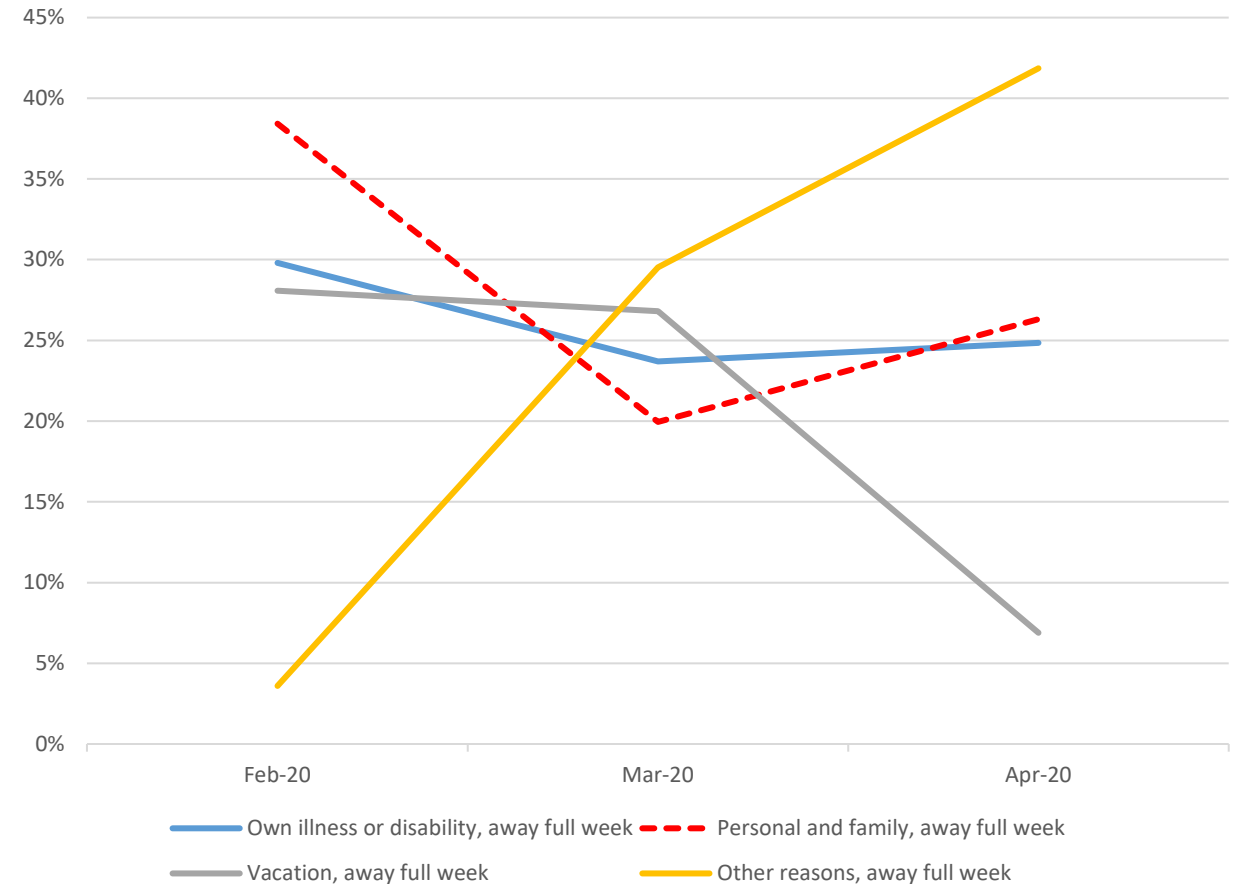
# 5. Women are taking on increased caregiving responsibilities



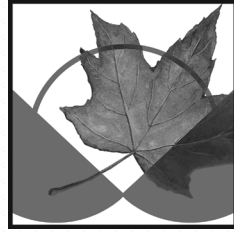
Share of usual hours (%) lost by reason for absence among male workers away for the whole week, January - April 2020
