

2022 COVID-19 Auditing Plan

- 2022 plan effective Jan 1 - Dec 31, 2022
- Biggest change: No more Doc-Only audits in 2022
- Alberta: No observations until March 31, 2022
- BC: No changes, In-person Observations still required.

COVID-19 Auditing

Documentation Only Audits

- Effective until Dec 31, 2021
- Conducted remotely
- Preferred if the audit includes Interviews as well

Discontinued
Jan 1, 2022

Virtual Options

- Document Reviews and Interviews Virtual
- BC requires in-person Observations
- No Observations in AB until March 31, 2022
- SK, MB etc. up to client on whether to include Observations

- No Observations
- Until March 31, 2022

British Columbia

- Virtual Doc & Int
- In-Person Observations

Other Provinces

- Employer can decide to follow AB requirements or BC requirements

COVID-19 Student Audits

Time frame

- 1 Year from end of Course
- Document review & interviews
- Observations after March 31

Limited Certification

- 2022 will need to submit a full audit to receive full certification

- Session will be provided

- PASE Program
- Roll Up Audits
- Medium Sized COR (MECOR)
- Safety Surveys
