The census is directed by and supported by the Ontario Ministry of Education. As noted in the Government of Ontario's Anti-Racism Strategic Plan, all school boards in Ontario will be required to collect race-based data.

The results of the student census will identify systemic barriers and bias within the education system. The results will help us make informed decisions about programming to support student success and allocate resources to where they are needed most.

CONFIDENTIALITY

The census will be completed online using Qualtrics, a secure software that has been rigorously assessed by Information Technology professionals and used by other school boards across Ontario.

Analysis and data reports will never single out a student. By law, we cannot reveal individual information for any student/parent who completes the survey.
