



## Overview of Curling Canada protocols for Hub City Events

*SUBJECT TO CHANGE – INITIALLY APPROVED BY ALBERTA HEALTH*

- Venue will be separated into three zones. Red/Blue/Green
- Green will be Field of Play (FOP) only and will have no crossover with other two zones
- Green Zone will include a hotel where only FOP approved athletes and staff are allowed to enter and leave
- Single rooms for anyone in the Green Zone
- When not in FOP or individual rooms anyone within the Green Zone will be required to follow all City of Calgary and Alberta Health guidelines, including indoor mask wearing, social distancing and hand-washing stations
- Green Zone attendees will be required to provide a negative PCR test within 72 hours before departure flight or driving to Championship
- Green Zone attendees will be PCR-tested on Day 0 (arrival) as well as Day 5, post-arrival
- Green Zone attendees will not be allowed to leave the Green Zone until departure from the event
- Meal plans will be in place
- Our intention is that international attendees for World Men's Championship will be required to arrive at minimum seven days in advance of Championship.
  - Same requirement of negative PCR test within 72 hours before departure flight
  - PCR-tested on Day 0 (arrival), Day 4, Day 8
- Positive PCR-test or symptomatic person will be required to immediately self-isolate and will be forwarded to Curling Canada-appointed Medical Officer, who will then work with the local health authorities on treatment.
  - If symptomatic or positive person is within the Green Zone, once medically stable, they will be removed and isolated in a safe and secure location
- Every person will be responsible to complete an online questionnaire each morning confirming no symptoms
- Every person will be temperature-tested upon entrance to their respective zones
