Q: Why not just implement paid meal breaks?
A: While in bargaining, the Government stated that paid meal breaks would not form part of the negotiations and the committees were not permitted to discuss this option.

Q: How will this change my pension?
A: Pensions would increase in value to reflect the higher yearly hours worked.
Q: What is the threshold for the vote to be accepted or defeated?
A: The threshold is fifty percent plus one vote.
Q: Will there be contract changes for annual leave or special leave?
A: All leave, benefits and collective agreement entitlements would be adjusted to reflect the longer day and longer workweek accordingly.

Q: What if the vote is successful but the government does not approve the joint committee's proposal to extend the work week.
A: The extended work week requires approval from government, if not, it fails, and Youth Corrections will remain on the current 35 -hour work week.
