Services will include primary care, mental health support, substance use support, social services, and peer support. Over 15 local agencies are partnering in Foundry East Kootenay.

Duncan	Canadian Mental Health Association - Cowichan Valley Branch 1992	Human and Social Services	\$ 72,194	Keeping Clients, Staff and Neighbours Safe - new, technologically scalable, high-definition security system will allow CMHACVB staff to visually identify high risk situations and individuals. The proposed new system would give us the latest networking and internet infrastructure and equipment, with high definition Closed Circuit TV surveillance cameras and will be updated annually for 10 years.

Mission	Mission Association for Community Living	Human and Social Services	\$ 179,290	MACLS Childcare Centre Society is partnering with the City of mission to build a childcare and early years hub, the City is responsible for the majority of building costs, while MACL is responsible for the acquisition of items to run the facility. The society is therefore looking to purchase 2 accessible busses and all the required furniture and toys to fill the programming and employee rooms.
Nelson	Nelson Seach and Rescue Society	Public Safety	\$ 63,000	Nelson SAR Boathouse The boat had been housed in a volunteer-built boathouse on a slip leased at the nelson launch club until 2020. Currently storing the boat at the prestige lakeside marina while the equipment for the boat is stored at another location. Without the boathouse, the boat and equipment are being exposed to elements year-round, and there is a theft and vandalism risk. Therefore, the society is seeking to build a boathouse at the prestige lakeside marina to house the equipment and boat safely together.
New Westminster	Westminster House Society	Human and Social Services	\$ 184,027	WHS Admission and Triage Capital Project Society is looking to construct a new admissions office to replace their existing office and provide better triage services to the vulnerable populations they serve. This will include a private counselling office, and food storage for the dining hall. Currently the society is using a garage conversion as their office and does not have space to accommodate additional workers.

North Vancouver	WBT Wild Bird Trust of British Columbia	Environment	\$ 217,775	Repairing Cultural and Ecological Relations at Maplewood Flats The society is seeking funds to create infrastructure in the park to advance connections between Tsleil-Waututh Nation members and the site. Specifically, they are looking to develop two outdoor classrooms and work spaces, design 6 interpretive panels, create a Coast Salish Demonstration Garden, install a harvest table, construct an innovation studio, and update their signage to deliver programming.

By moving the Seniors Hub and Volunteer Services to this location, more space will open at a second location for Sources Counselling and Substance Use Services to provide programming for clients. by connecting the separate upstairs bays to offer office, volunteer and programming space on the 2nd space; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Install a lift providing accessibility to 2nd floor programming and community kitchen space for all users, volunteers and staff unable to access via the stairs; • Redevelop the current reception area to create an area that is welcoming and conducive for private conversations in meeting the needs of the community, while providing physical distancing as needed. • Improve the overall accessibility of the physical space for people with mobility barriers, including the installation of automatic doors.

Prior to the pandemic they had been doing all of these in person which put a cap on the capacity. They've now started using webinars and other online means but the LMS would give them a virtual environment for participants to access anywhere, asynchronous content delivery, a more consistent experience, analytics, a dementia friendly interface, and a more efficient platform.</p>
