# D69 Swimming Pool Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 899 Adding Electoral Area E at 100 Percent Usage Apportionment

It was moved and seconded that the report titled "RDN District 69 Swimming Pool Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 899 - Adding Electoral Area E at 100 Percent Usage Apportionment" be received for information.

It was moved and seconded that the spreadsheet distributed to the committee on July 24, 2023, which notes apportionment options 7-10 for Bylaw 899 be added as a late attachment to item 7.1 D69 Swimming Pool Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 899 Adding Electoral Area E at 100 Percent Usage Apportionment.

- 1. The renovation of the Ravensong Aquatic Facility be put on hold and be re-examined in 2025, and that contributions to reserves for renovations at the Ravensong Aquatic Centre be set at zero for the 2024 budget;
- "Regional District of Nanaimo District 69 Swimming Pool Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 899, 1993" be amended to include Electoral Areas E, F, G, H, City of Parksville and Town of Qualicum Beach, based on an apportionment model of 100% usage; and further,
- 3. The apportionment model be re-examined in 2025.
