Six Mile Lake – 2022 Fishing Derby

Rules:

- a) Respect fish you intend to release.
- b) The Six Mile Lake Fishing Derby is a fishing contest which is open from June 25 through September 5, 2022 for all open season fish species on Six Mile Lake.
- c) Junior Angler shall not be aged over 19 for any day of the Derby.
- d) Most Accumulated Inches, Largest Pike, Largest Bass, Largest Walleye, and Most Outstanding Fish Classes Champion can be any age.
- e) Champion of each Class will be awarded a traveling trophy, to be returned and passed to the 2023 season Champion.
- f) Outstanding catch will be awarded to person with most outstanding catch photograph taken during the 2022 Derby season.
- g) All fish 10" and above are eligible to be logged on the provided Catch Log (please complete all details). Catch Logs can be requested from: smlfishingderby@gmail.com.
- h) All catches to be signed off by a witness.
- i) Use measuring device to measure total fish length. If possible, capture a photo when you land those big ones!
- j) Submit Catch Log to: smlfishingderby@gmail.com by September 10, 2022. Submissions will be accepted as frequently as received.
- k) All submissions must be caught on Six Mile Lake by a properly licensed angler.
- All participants are expected to practice courtesy, safety and agree to abide by all regulations of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry, Transport Canada, and by the rules of the Six Mile Lake Fishing Derby.
- m) Entry fee (\$10 single fee, \$20 household fee) must be paid electronically before submission of catch.
- n) Entrants may be disqualified at any time for failure of abiding rules.
