A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE A MUNICIPAL TICKET INFORMATION SYSTEM

The Council of the District of Squamish in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. CITATION:

This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “District of Squamish Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 1832, 2004”

2. REPEAL:

The “District of Squamish Ticket Information Bylaw No. 1318, 1994” and all amendments thereto, are hereby repealed.

3. GENERAL:

1. The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule “A” of this bylaw are designated pursuant to s.264(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c.26 as bylaws enforceable by means of a ticket in the form prescribed in the *Community Charter Bylaw Enforcement Ticket Regulation* , *B.C. Reg. 425/2003*.
2. The persons who act in the job position or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule “A” of this bylaw are designated pursuant to s.264(1)(b) of the *Community Charter* , as bylaw enforcement officers for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule “A” opposite the respective job position.
3. The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedules “B” through “AA” of this bylaw are authorized pursuant to s.264(1)(c) of the *Community Charter* to designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2 opposite the respective words or expressions (as amended by Bylaw 2646).
4. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules “B” through “AA” of this bylaw are the fines established by Council pursuant to s.265(1)(a) of the *Community Charter* for the corresponding offence designated in Column 1 (as amended by Bylaw 2646).
