



U.S. COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Administered by Vaccine Type



January 4, 2020 - April 10, 2021



Between mid-March and mid-October 2020, the number of mental health related ER visits, per 100,000 total visits, rose from the year-earlier period by 24% for 5 to 11-year-olds and by 31% for 12 to 17-year-olds, according to data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.1

Share of COVID-19 Deaths vs. Percent of Age Population with at Least One COVID-19 Vaccine Dose in the U.S.



The Texas Rangers welcomed a crowd of at least 38,000 fans to Globe Life Field in Arlington on April 5th for the team's home opener against the Toronto Blue Jays. Percent of U.S. Inpatient Beds Occupied by COVID-19 Patients


