





Total Deaths and COVID-19 Deaths in the U.S. by Age Group


Influenza Deaths of Children Aged 0-17 (2010-2019) vs. COVID-19 Deaths of Children Aged 0-17

including Notre Dame, the University of North Carolina, and Illinois State had reported some 26,000 cases by September 9, 2020, yet no hospitalizations.1


COVID-19 Deaths by Age vs. Share of Population in the U.S.
