Summer INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGE Programs

Summer International Language Programs provide an opportunity for students in Elementary School to develop and/or maintain the ability to speak, listen, read and write in a new language or the language of their heritage.

Program runs July 4 to 28, 2023

- Enhances students' connection with their heritage.
- Improves communication skills in their language of choice.
- Strengthens cognitive development through the knowledge of an additional language.
- Provides opportunities to learn and experience another culture.

Eligibility: Students eligible to attend an Ontario Elementary school in the 2022-2023 school year are able to attend one class in each available language for FREE¹. Additional classes in the same language are available for a fee of \$125 per student per additional course. VISA students are able to participate for a fee of \$125 per course.

NO device deployment is available for the ILE Program or for students from outside HWDSB. One device per family.

REACH AHEAD (On-Line) Credit Program

Summer Reach Ahead programs provide Grade 8 students an opportunity to earn their compulsory Civics and/or Careers courses during the summer before Grade 9. Participating in Summer Reach Ahead programs helps to keep your student learning and engaged through the summer and enhances the transition experience for Grade 8 students as they move to Secondary School. **New in 2023** - courses will be available in both English and French
